

Deco Mesh Snowman

You'll Need:

- 4 rolls – White Mesh – XB905-01 – Aisle 1
- 2ea – Red Berry Cedar Pick – FX76406B – Aisle 28
- 2ea – Red Skate – 82101RD – Aisle 27
- 1ea – Black Glitter Hat – 82670BK – Aisle 27
- 3ea – Xmas Pick Berry Holly Leaves – 30028432 – Aisle 28
- 1ea – Corn Cob Pipe – 3100-394 – Aisle 27, 1
- 1pkg – Small Glitter Snowflakes – 2469-35 – Aisle 27
- 1pkg – Large Glitter Snowflakes – 1619-60 – Aisle 27
- 2ea – Pinecone Berry Pick – 30031411 – Aisle 28
- 1ea – Burlap Carrot – 2875-304 – Aisle 5, 27
- 1ea – 10" Wire Wreath Form – 170120 – Aisle 1
- 1ea – 12" Wire Wreath Form – 170130 – Aisle 1
- 1ea – 14" Wire Wreath Form – 170140 – Aisle 1
- 1pkg – Wooden Circles – 9161-41 – Aisle 8
- Glue Gun – Aisle 6
- Glue Sticks – Aisle 6
- 1pkg – Large Pack White Pipe Cleaners – 1084-10 – Aisle 1
- 6yds – Red Ribbon (5yds for Bow, 1yd for around neck) – X620740-12 – Aisle 1
- 1ea – Americana Coral Blush Paint – DA292 – Aisle 2
- 1ea – Crafter's Acrylic Black Paint – DCA47 – Aisle 2



Directions:

1. Take one of the wire wreath forms, it doesn't matter which you start with. Starting with the second ring from the outside, tie a chenille stem around each crossbar with the ends pointing up. On the third ring from the outside, tie a chenille stem on the ring in the middle between each set of crossbars. Do the same with the other wreath forms. The 10" form should have 10 chenille stems on it, the 12" form should have 12 chenille stems on it and the 14" should have 14 stems on it. The stems should be arranged in a kind of "zig-zag" pattern around the ring. **On the next page are examples of each form. Dots are chenille stem locations.**
2. You are going to use 1 roll of mesh for the head, 1 ¼ roll mesh for the middle, and 1 ¾ roll mesh for the bottom form. Pick which wreath form you'd like to start with. Start your mesh on the outer ring. Tie the end of the mesh down with the first chenille stem. Take 10" of the mesh and bunch it up. Tie the end of the 10" strip down with the next chenille stem. Go all the way around the ring using this process. Once you have tied the last stem on the outer ring, go onto the inner ring, but **don't cut your mesh!** Repeat this

process on the inner ring. Once you've gone all the way around this ring, bunch the leftover mesh from one side of the wreath form to the other and cover the middle of the form. Tie your mesh off with a chenille stem or glue it down at the end. Fluff the mesh to cover any holes. Repeat this entire step with the other wreath forms.

3. Tie the wreath forms together with chenille stems. Paint the wooden circles black and let dry. Glue small snowflakes to the middle of the circles to complete the eyes. Paint a little of the blush paint onto the mesh to make its rosy cheeks. Glue everything onto your snowman. Make a 5yd bow and glue 2 picks into the bow. Tie 1 yard of the same ribbon around the neck to make your scarf. Hang the skates from one of the arms and make a hanger for your snowman with a chenille stem and you're done! 😊
