USA Chalky Paint Jars



Supplies You'll Need

- Mason Jar
- <u>Chalk Paint</u> (Rouge, Lace and Honor)
- Deep Brown Crème Wax
- Sponge Brush
- Burlap Strips
- <u>1"</u> and <u>1 ³/</u> Metal Stars
- <u>Ribbon</u>
- 20ct Clear Light Set

Directions

Large Mason Jar

- 1. Paint the entire jar with 2 coats of the Lace chalk paint with the sponge brush and let dry.
- 2. Apply one coat of the Deep Brown crème wax to the jar and let dry.

Jar with Etched Stars

- 1. Paint the entire jar with one light coat of the Lace chalk paint. Once dry, apply light coats of the Rouge and Honor chalk paint as desired. *Make sure you don't make the coats too thick or you won't be able to see the lights shining through!* Let dry.
- 2. Scrape the paint off to make the stars wherever you'd like them to be!
- 3. Tie ribbon around the top of the jar and into a bow. Put the lights in the jar and you're done!

Jar with Metal Stars

- 1. Paint the entire jar with one light coat of the Lace chalk paint. *Make sure you don't make the coat too thick or you won't be able to see the lights shining through!* Once dry, paint the burlap strips with the Rouge and Honor chalk paint and press the burlap strips onto the jar as desired. Let dry.
- 2. Hot glue the metal stars to the outside of the jar. Tie the ribbon around the top of the jar and into a bow. Put the lights in the jar and you're done!
