

UT Volunteers Bandana Wreath



Supplies:

- 12 White Bandanas
- 12 Orange Bandanas
- 14 Inch Straw Wreath (RHY-SW14)
- White Wood Letters V, O, L, S
- Wooden Football (9190-006)
- White Chenille Stems
- Orange Chenille Stems
- 1 Bottle Spice Brown Paint
- 1 Bottle White Paint
- 4yds Football Ribbon

Instructions:

1. Fold each bandana in half 3 times so you end up with about a 2 ½ inch to 3 inch strip of bandana. The pattern on the bandana doesn't matter; just make sure that you fold every bandana the same way so you have the same pattern on each.
2. Tie the white bandanas on the straw wreath with the white chenille stems first. The edges of the bandanas can touch, but do not overlap them. Space them evenly around the wreath. Next, tie the orange bandanas around the wreath using the orange chenille stems. Each bandana should overlap part of 2 white bandanas and it should be tied in between them.
3. Paint the wooden football with the brown and white paint. Use a hot glue gun to attach the football and wooden letters to the wreath.
4. Use the football ribbon to make a bow. Use a chenille stem to secure the bow to the wreath. Use another chenille stem to make a loop to hang the wreath.
5. You're done! 😊
