## <u>Ben Franklin Crafts – Monogram Fabric Letter Project!</u>

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## **Supplies**

- -3 pieces of fabric ¼ yard each
- -1 wooden letter your choice
- -Rhinestones
- -2 colors of grosgrain ribbon 2 yards each
- -Mod Podge<sup>®</sup> Fabric
- -Mod Podge® Gloss
- -Sponge Brush
- -Hot glue gun

-2 Colors of your choice of lace (enough to wrap the entire outside of whatever letter you choose)

## **Instructions**

- 1. Cut fabric in small pieces around 3" x 3" but the size and shape is up to you
- 2. Apply Mod Podge<sup>®</sup> Fabric to the wooden letter with the sponge brush. Just a little larger area than your piece of fabric.
- 3. Attach your fabric to the wooden letter and go over the top with the Mod Podge<sup>®</sup> Fabric again. Make sure not to leave any wrinkles.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until the entire surface of the letter is covered.
- 5. Go over the entire surface of the letter with the Mod Podge<sup>®</sup> Gloss to give it a nice luster.
- 6. When that is dry, use the hot glue gun to attach the lace to the back of the letter.
- 7. Hot glue the rhinestones to the surface and any bows you may want. Also attach the Ribbon to the back to make a hanger.
