

## 5ft Primitive Snowman Tree Project (2016)

1. Fluff the 5ft Mt Alpine tree (don't use the topper)
2. Take your burlap and bunch up one end and start at the bottom where the wood trunk begins. Going around the tree bunch up about 12 to 16 inches of the burlap and tuck it and use a pine branch to wrap around the burlap to hold it in place. Continue doing this around the tree until you cover the tree
3. Wrap 1 of the sets of 140ct brown wire clear lights around the outside of the burlap starting at the bottom all the way to the top.
4. Take some of the polyfill and stuff inside the top hat of the snowman head until it stands up on its own. Use a piece of black felt to cover the top of the hat and glue in place. Cut a small hole in the mouth, put some hot glue on the end of the corn cob pipe and insert into hole. Glue a rusty snowflake to the front of the hat
5. Place snowman head on the top of the tree and glue to the top of the wood trunk.
6. Pull some of the burlap around the bottom of the snowman head and secure with hot glue (if needed)
7. Hot glue the grapevine balls and rusty snowflakes to the front of the snowman
8. To make the scarf: take the ribbon, tie around the snowman's neck and tuck, securing with hot glue
9. Tuck the arms in the tree. Glue the bird onto one of the arms and put the sign on the other arm.
10. Lay out your piece of red burlap and set the tree in the middle of the fabric. Put some of the polyfill around the tree trunk and then gather the fabric around the trunk and tie with the jute string.
11. Enjoy your snowman tree!
