- 1. Fluff the 5ft Mt Alpine tree (don't use the topper). Wrap the 100ct clear lights around the tree BEFORE you put the mesh on.
- 2. Take your mesh and bunch up one end and start at the bottom where the wood trunk begins. Going around the tree bunch up about 8 to 12 inches of the mesh and tuck it and use a pine branch to wrap around the burlap to hold it in place. Continue doing this around the tree until you cover the tree.
- 3. Wrap the 140ct white wire clear lights around the outside of the mesh starting at the bottom all the way to the top.
- 4. Place snowman head on the top of the tree and glue to the top of the wood trunk.
- 5. Hot glue the grapevine balls to the front of the snowman.
- 6. Tuck the arms in the tree. Glue the bird onto one of the arms and put the sign on the other arm.
- 7. Glue snowflakes on the mesh as well as the hat on the snowman head.
- 8. Put the polyfill on the felt for the bottom of the tree. Fold the felt up and tie it with the ribbon. Tie the bow around the ribbon tie.
- 9. You're done!
