

## Burlap Scarecrow Head

### You'll Need:



- 1 yd – Burlap Fabric
- 1 bag – Polyfill
- ½ yd – Black Cord (for mouth)
- 1ea – Large Hat
- 2ea – Leaf Bush
- 1ea – Daisy Bush
- 24in – Orange Burlap Ribbon
- 1 ½ yd – Burlap Ribbon
- 1 sheet – Yellow Felt
- 1ea – Orange Bandana
- 1 pkg – Raffia
- 1 pkg – Black Buttons
- Jute String

### Directions

1. Fold your burlap fabric in half “hamburger style”. Stuff the polyfill into the burlap and secure the bottom with a chenille stem. Tie your bandana around the chenille stem.
2. Cut some pieces of raffia and pick some leaves and flowers and glue these onto the burlap above the bandana.
3. Glue the hat on top of your scarecrow’s head and secure the front and back of the hat with a chenille stem or jute string if you like. Just stick the stem or string through a couple holes in the hat and push it through the burlap and tie it. Your hat is more apt to fall off if you don’t tie it down. Glue your ribbon and bow to his hat.
4. Cut some more pieces of raffia and pick some leaves and flowers and glue these under his hat to make his hair.
5. Cut your felt into small circles to make his eyes. Use some jute string and tie through the holes in the buttons to finish off his eyes. Just glue these onto each other and then onto the burlap. Find a good leaf and cut it into a nose shape and glue this onto his face as well. Finally, glue some black jute string onto the burlap to create his mouth.
6. To hang, just use a chenille stem to make a loop and tie the stem to the back of your scarecrow and you’re done! 😊
