

Burlap Sunflower

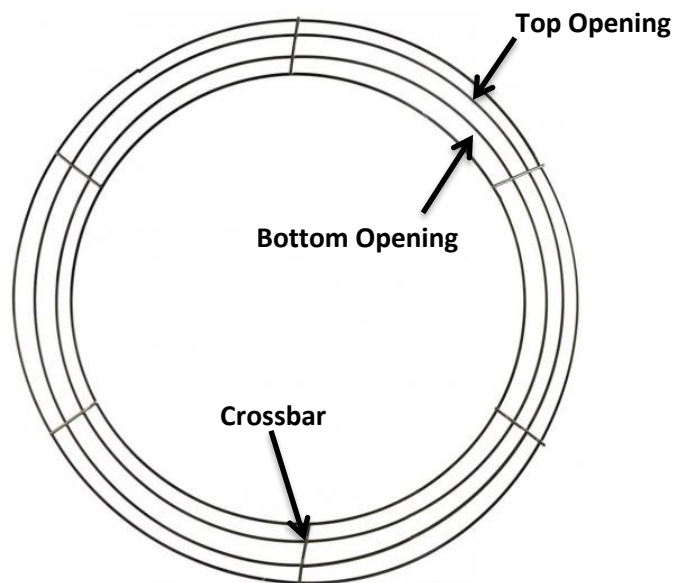


You'll Need:

- 1ea – 16” Wire Wreath Form
- 1ea – 8” Wire Wreath Form
- 1 roll – 12” Yellow Burlap
- 1 roll – 6” Natural Burlap
- 1ea – Sunflower Stem
- 1ea – Small Sign
- 2 yards – Bee Ribbon
- 1 ½ yards – Green Ribbon
- Hot glue and hot glue gun

Directions:

1. Unroll part of the 12” yellow burlap. Pull one side of the burlap through the top opening of the 16” wreath form, and pull the other side through the bottom opening. Pull the burlap out a little further on the outer rim. This will make your wreath seem larger and give you more of a “petal” effect. Tie down the burlap with a chenille stem.
2. Keep pulling both sides at the same time and make sure to pull tight. The tighter you pull the burlap, the fuller your wreath will be.



3. For your 8” wreath form, you’re going to complete steps 1-2, but you’re going to pull the 6” natural burlap around the each of the 2 middle rings, making it fuller and tighter. Tie your wreath forms together.

4. To make your leaves, cut 3 strips of ribbon, each 12" long. Fold it like a breast cancer awareness bow, and glue it together. Tie the "leaf" into the burlap, and secure with a little hot glue.
5. Tie your bow and glue it onto the wreath. Glue the flowers and sign onto the wreath.
6. You're done! 😊
