

Grapevine Snowman



You'll Need:

- 1ea – 10" Grapevine
- 1ea – 12" Grapevine Wreath
- 1ea – 18" Grapevine Wreath
- 1ea – Hat
- 2ea – Pine Sprays (for the arms)
- 2yds – Plaid Ribbon
- 3yds – Merry Christmas Ribbon
- 2ea – Mittens
- 3ea – Snowflake
- 1ea – 62ct Light String
- 1ea – Merry Christmas Sign
- 1ea – Pine Berry Pick
- Brown Chenille Stems

Directions:

1. Tie the wreaths together with chenille stems. Starting with the battery box at the top, wind the light string around the wreaths, going all the way to the bottom of the snowman and back up the other side. Attach the snowflakes in the middle of each of the wreaths.
2. Take the ribbon that comes on the hat off and replace with some of the plaid ribbon. Glue it down along with the pine pick and allow it to dry. Glue the hat onto the snowman and use it to hide the battery box. Use the rest of the plaid ribbon to tie a scarf around the snowman and glue it down. Tie a bow with the Merry Christmas ribbon and glue it on as well.
3. Glue the pine spray arms on and allow them to dry. Glue the Merry Christmas Sign to one of the sprays and add the mittens to the other side.
4. Make a hook with a chenille stem to hang your new snowman and you're done! 😊
