

## Lighted Scarecrow Jar



### You'll Need:

- 1ea – ½ Gallon Jar
- 1ea – 35ct Deco Lights
- 1ea – 10"x14" Jute Bag
- 1ea – 12" Hat
- 1pk – Black Buttons
- 1ea – Scribbles Black Paint
- 1ea – Ceramcoat Bittersweet Orange
- 1ea – Ceramcoat Ivory
- 1ea – Ceramcoat Mendocino Red
- 2yds – Orange Burlap Ribbon
- 1pkg – Raffia
- 1ea – Leaf Bush
- 1ea – Sunflower
- 1 roll – Orange Ribbon
- 1pkg – Beige Chenille Stems

### Directions:

1. Stick your Deco Lights into the jar. Make sure your electrical plug-in end is out of the jar so you can plug the lights in. Place the jar in the burlap bag and pull the ties on the top of the bag.
2. Use the Ceramcoat paint to paint the eyes and nose and cheeks. Outline the eyes and nose with the Scribbles paint and use this paint to make your mouth.
3. Run some of the small orange ribbon through the holes in the buttons and tie a small bow in the middle. Glue the buttons onto the burlap.
4. Clump your raffia and tie a chenille stem around it to make the hair. Tie this same chenille stem around the top of the burlap bag. Repeat this step on the back of the jar.
5. Glue some flowers in the hair and glue your bow tie on the front of the jar. Decorate your hat and glue or set it on top. *Gluing the hat down just makes it a more stable and less likely to fall off.*
6. You're done! ☺
