

## Scarecrow Hat



### You'll Need:

- 1 pkg – Raffia
- 1 pkg – Black Buttons
- 1ea – 18” Straw Hat
- 2ea – Leaf Bushes
- 2ea – Flower Bushes
- 1 pkg – Fern Pins
- 1ea – Black Scribbles Paint
- 1ea – 2” Straw Hat
- 1ea – Ceramcoat Coral
- 1ea – Crafter’s Acrylic Orange Spice
- 1ea – Ceramcoat Pumpkin
- 1ea – Small Orange Ribbon
- 1ea – 2yd bow (ribbon your choice)

### Directions:

1. Split the raffia into 2 equal amounts. Overlap the bunches a little at the top (to make the bangs) and glue the raffia onto the 18” straw hat. Fold the top of the hat down over the raffia and secure it with a fern pin. You can also add some hot glue to make the hold stronger.
2. Glue the buttons on to make the eyes. Tie little bows with the small orange ribbon and glue them above the buttons to make the eyebrows/eyelashes. Paint the 2” straw hat with the pumpkin paint and black Scribbles paint. Let it dry and glue it onto the hat. Paint the mouth and cheeks with the orange spice and black paint and allow to dry.
3. Tie your bow and use a fern pin to secure it to the hat. You can also add some glue to make the hold stronger. Pull some leaves and flowers and berries from the bushes and glue these onto the hat. Be sure to save a couple leaves for the bows in your scarecrow’s hair! Tie some orange ribbon around the raffia and glue the leaves onto the ribbon to make the bows.
4. You’re done! 😊
